- Guides decisions on land use and preservation, transportation, housing, development, environment
- Coordinates local planning efforts
- Fulfills State of Maryland requirement





A comprehensive plan is not:

- A regulation
- An ordinance
- Zoning





A comprehensive plan, upon adoption, <u>does not</u>:

- Create new regulations
- Change existing zoning
- Alter the development rights allowed by each propertyis existing zoning

 - Supporting Goals & Recommendations
 - Future Development Guide
 - 10-Year Action Plan for Implementation
- Public Input:
 - Helps prioritize needs and opportunities
 - Helps establish community vision for growth and preservation


How often is the Plan updated?

- Other plans to consider during this update
 - Municipal comprehensive plans
 - QAC Housing Study
 - QAC LPPRP
 - QAC Comprehensive Water & Sewerage Plan
 - MD Transportation Plan
 - And many other plans and data sources


