What is a Comprehensive Plan?



- Blueprint for the future: 20-year horizon
- Establishes a community vision for growth and preservation over the next 20 years
- Guides decisions on land use and preservation, transportation, housing, development, environment
- Coordinates local planning efforts
- Fulfills State of Maryland requirement

What is a Comprehensive Plan?



A comprehensive plan is not:

- A regulation
- An ordinance
- Zoning

What is a Comprehensive Plan?



A comprehensive plan, upon adoption, does not:

- Create new regulations
- Change existing zoning
- Alter the development rights allowed by each property's existing zoning

What is a Comprehensive Plan?



- Main Components:
 - Needs & Opportunities
 - Supporting Goals & Recommendations
 - Future Development Guide
 - 10-Year Action Plan for Implementation
- Public Input:
 - Helps prioritize needs and opportunities
 - Helps establish community vision for growth and preservation
 - Helps identify desired development patterns



- Previous planning efforts
 - 2010 Comprehensive Plan
 - 2006 Kent Narrows Community Plan
 - 2007 Chester/Stevensville Community Plan
 - 2010 Grasonville Community Plan
- Other plans to consider during this update
 - Municipal comprehensive plans
 - QAC Housing Study
 - QAC LPPRP
 - QAC Comprehensive Water & Sewerage Plan
 - MD Transportation Plan
 - And many other plans and data sources

- Provides overall "big picture" guidance for the entire Comprehensive Plan
- Is supported by all the goals and policies in the Comprehensive Plan
- Is often formatted as a short paragraph

- A county that encourages agriculture, seafood and maritime industries, tourism and outdoor sports, small business and high-tech enterprise ñ a good place to work;
- A county that is a faithful steward of its natural and cultural heritage ñ a good neighbor for the Bay and other Eastern Shore counties;
- A county in which development does not impair the quality of life enjoyed by all ñ a community that protects the expectations and opportunities of all its citizens.
- A county that supports the highest quality of education that seeks to fully prepare its citizens for the future.
