


Why Update the Comprehensive and Community Plans? Project Purpose

- Things in the natural and built environment change
- Local priorities and <u>vision</u> change with time
- New data have been collected and released
- New issues and opportunities arise
- Strategies to achieve identified vision and goals have to be adjusted
- Time since last adoption
 - County Comprehensive Plan 11 years old (2010)
 - Chester/Stevensville Community Plan 14 years old (2007)
 - Grasonville Community Plan 11 years old (2010)
 - Kent Narrows Community Plan 15 years old (2006)
